## The Germination of Rhododendron Seed

The process of germinating rhododendron seed is not difficult or complicated, but it sometimes takes a while. You will need a wide-mouth jar, some ordinary peat moss, some sphagnum moss that can be gathered locally from oak or maple trees and dried in the oven at very low temperature, and a bit of saran wrap.

Moisten enough peat moss to pack fairly tight in the bottom three inches of the jar. Rub sphagnum moss through a 1/8" screen and after moistening it, pack 1/4" on top of the peat. Water until all moss is soaked thoroughly but no water will run off when the jar is tipped. Sprinkle the seed sparingly on top of the sphagnum. *Do not cover seed.* Stretch a bit of saran wrap over the top of the jar and secure with a rubber band.

Set the jar in a warm place but not in direct sunlight until germination occurs. When you see the first tiny seedlings appear, apply a very dilute fertilizer and place under a light. I use a 4-foot 2-tube fluorescent light about 6" above the seedlings.

When seedlings are about 1" tall, poke a pencil through the saran wrap two or three times to let the air into the jar. Check to be sure the sphagnum has not dried out. After two weeks take the saran wrap off so seedlings can harden a bit. After two more weeks transplant seedlings to flats or individual pots, not closer than 2" apart.

Use peat moss and vermiculite or sand as a planting medium. Fertilize monthly, water as needed, provide good light and keep over 60°F for continued growth. Plants will soon reach 4"-5" in height and are then handled like rooted cuttings.
